Academics

What courses are available?

- ❖ Any level of Spanish language **1000 – 4000** and graduate-level coursework
- ❖ Conversation Credit
- ❖ Phonetics and Phonology
- ❖ Literature, Civilization, and Culture courses
- ❖ Spanish for Professionals (Business or Healthcare Tracks)
- ❖ International Economics (Taught in English) and possibly Principles of Macroeconomics.

The University of Cádiz (La UCA)

- ❖ All classes will take place at the University of Cádiz, in Cádiz, Spain, which is located in Andalucía on the southern tip of Spain.
- ❖ Classes run Monday – Thursday and focus on developing speaking proficiency rather than on grammar.
- ❖ Courses at La UCA utilize innovative techniques for teaching Spanish (communicative and task-based teaching)

Program cost

How much does it cost?

- ❖ \$4,850 plus VSU Tuition
- ❖ Hope Scholarship covers VSU tuition / Pell grants may also be applied
- ❖ Payment Deadlines:

February 15, 2020: \$200 deposit

February 15, 2020 : \$2,325 1st Installment

April 1, 2020: \$2,325 Final Installment

Note: Those who apply for the Gilman scholarship will want to apply to the program ASAP!

What does the program include?

- ❖ **Round trip airfare** from Atlanta to Madrid
- ❖ **Transportation** within Spain (for excursions and airport transfers)
- ❖ **Four nights in Madrid** in a 4-star hotel
- ❖ Overnight excursion to **Córdoba** and day trip to **Segovia**
- ❖ **Room and Board** for **4 weeks in Cádiz**
- ❖ **Weekly laundry** Service
- ❖ **Program fees** at the University of Cádiz
- ❖ **Excursions** to: Sevilla, Pueblos Blancos, & EL Puerto de Santa María (bodega & castle)
- ❖ **International health insurance**
- ❖ **Trip cancellation insurance**

- ❖ Gilman – McCain Scholarship (for military dependents)
- ❖ LCOBA Scholarships (for business students)

Scholarships for CoH&SS students

Benjamin T. Gilman Scholarship

- ❖ Must be a Pell Grant recipient
- ❖ **SIX Cádiz students were** Gilman winners last year (average award: \$3,000 - \$4,000)! **Only 8 applied, so 6 of 8 won!!!**
- ❖ If you plan to apply for the Gilman, start early and leave time for Dr. Russell to edit your application!
- ❖ Early Summer Deadline: October 1, 2019

Gilman McCain Scholarship

- ❖ Same deadlines as the Gilman (Oct. 1, 2019)
- ❖ Designed specifically for military dependents who receive any type of financial aid

All students stay in the historic district of Cádiz, which is within walking distance of the University of Cádiz.



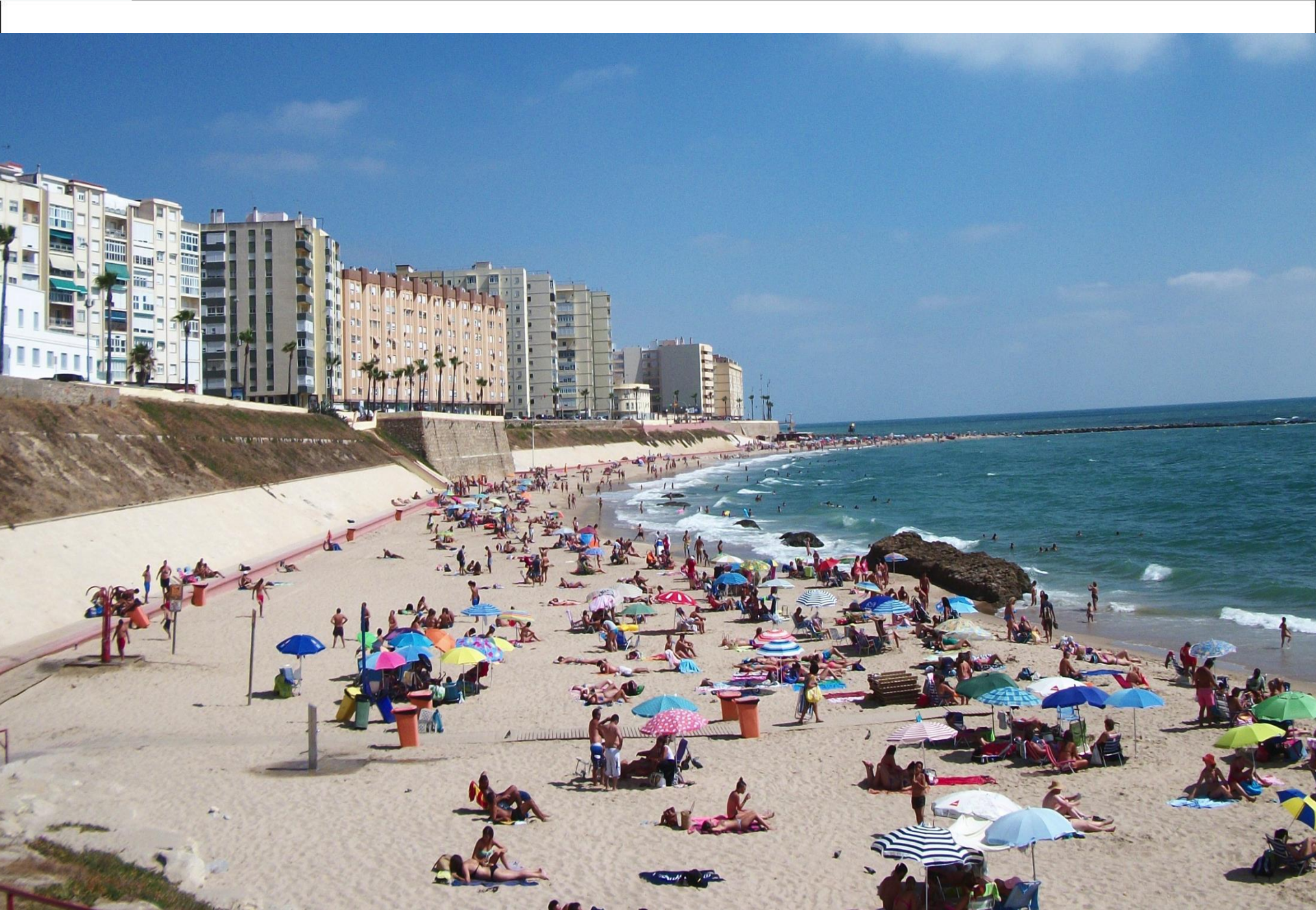
Plaza San Fernando
