Academics

What courses are available?

- ❖ Any level of Spanish language **1000 – 4000** and graduate coursework
- ❖ Conversation Credit
- ❖ Phonetics and Phonology
- ❖ Literature, Civilization, and Culture courses
- ❖ Spanish for Professionals (Business or Healthcare Tracks)
- ❖ International Economics (Taught in English)

The University of Cádiz (La UCA)

- ❖ All classes will take place at the University of Cádiz, in Cádiz, Spain, which is located in Andalucía on the southern tip of Spain.
- ❖ Classes run Monday – Thursday and focus on developing speaking proficiency rather than on grammar.
- ❖ Courses at La UCA utilize innovative techniques for teaching Spanish (communicative and task-based teaching)

Program cost

How much does it cost?

- ❖ \$4,950 plus VSU Tuition
- ❖ Hope Scholarship covers VSU tuition / Pell grants may also be applied
- ❖ Payment Deadlines:

October 31, 2017:	\$200	deposit
February 1, 2018:	\$2,225	1st Installment
April 15, 2018:	\$2,225	Final Installment

What does the program include?

- ❖ Round trip **airfare** from Atlanta to Madrid
- ❖ **Transportation** within Spain (for excursions and airport transfers)
- ❖ Four nights in Madrid in a 4-star hotel
- ❖ Overnight excursion to **Córdoba** and day trip to **Segovia**
- ❖ **Room and Board** for **4 weeks** in **Cádiz**
- ❖ Weekly **Laundry** Service
- ❖ Program fees at the University of Cádiz
- ❖ **Excursions** to: Sevilla, Pueblos Blancos, & EL Puerto de Santa María (bodega & castle)
- ❖ International health insurance

Scholarships and funding opportunities

Funding & Scholarship Information

- ❖ Internal scholarships are available (\$1,000 and \$500)
- ❖ You must apply to the program and pay your \$200 deposit by **October 31, 2017** to be eligible for internal awards
- ❖ Scholarship applications are due by November 30, 2017
- ❖ The committee will meet in February to determine the winners. The awards will apply to the final payment.

Benjamin T. Gilman Scholarship

- ❖ The Gilman award is available: \$2,500 - \$5,000
- ❖ Must be a Pell Grant recipient
- ❖ ***Eight Cádiz students were*** Gilman winners last year (average award for early summer: \$4,000)!
- ❖ If you plan to apply for the Gilman, start early and leave time for Dr. Russell to edit your application!
- ❖ Early Summer Deadline: October 3, 2017
Regular Summer Deadline: March 6, 2018

Other Funding

- ❖ Yankee Candles will be available to sell later this semester. 40% of proceeds go to your study abroad account!
- ❖ Fellowship Travel Raffle: \$1,000 and \$500
- ❖ Private funding: support letters, raffles, funding websites
